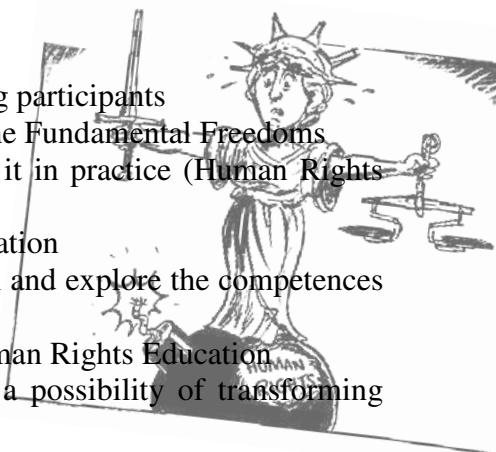
About the training

The Training Course “**Empowering the Learning – Discovering the Rights**” aims to develop the capacity and to train 24 youth workers in the area of Human Rights Education, Learning through/about Human Rights and with a strong multiplying effect by developing the skills of a HR Educator. In frame of the project, participants will have the opportunity to explore and to develop their training competences and put them into practice by creating sessions and projects within the Youth in Action Programme. So, the main topics to be explored are going to be: Human Rights Education, Facilitating and Training competences and Youth in Action Programme.

The Training will be run in Chisinau, Republic of Moldova having on board 24 participants as a result of a cooperation between 4 programme countries (Lithuania, Poland, Portugal, France) and 4 EECA countries (Moldova, Georgia, Azerbaijan, Armenia).

Objectives:

- to increase the understanding of Human Rights Education among participants
- to raise the awareness of the importance of Human Rights and the Fundamental Freedoms
- to strengthen the knowledge regarding Human Rights and put it in practice (Human Rights from Past to Future)
- to explore the understanding of poverty as a Human Rights Violation
- to train new facilitators and trainers in Human Rights Education and explore the competences of Human Rights Educator
- to explore the learning process via non formal education for Human Rights Education
- to introduce and explore “Youth in Action” - Programme as a possibility of transforming Human Rights into action
- to create new non-formal education tools and new innovative projects related to Human Rights Education



Target group:

Group leaders and youth workers who want to learn about Human Rights and develop their facilitating and training skills in the area of Human Rights Education. The training is designed for youth workers with less experience in HRE but with a strong responsibility for the follow up. Participants should be able to communicate in English and have full attendees.





Project Dates

You are expected to arrive on **July, 18** before 19.00 and departure on **July, 25** before 12.00 (after breakfast). If you plan to come earlier or stay after, you will be responsible for your stay.

Travel tricks

No money / No fun – Financial Issues

Regarding the **Travel Reimbursement** – 70% of your travel expenses will be reimbursed based on the Youth in Action rules and in the limits of the travel budget. It will be made on spot or as agreed, based on the travel documents such us: ticket, invoice and boarding passes.

The **insurance** will be on your own responsibility, without being reimbursed.... it is not controlled at the border but we insist on.

P.S. The international advice not to change money at the airport is not valid in Moldova. The rates are the same as in the city.
